


## "Success"

- Surface-level reading of source material











## Directors and writers?


- Conflicting direction and writing styles emphasise main theme
- Taken to extremes with combination of chiptune and orchestral music







### Shared universes undermine themes

- Fach of the traditional stories has an interloper who defeats the purpose
- Episode summaries and live reading aim to hammer this point home











### Goals and rewards

- Shallow backer rewards parody Kickstarter to highlight central thesis
- Repeated Zeus-themed merchandise undermines Zeus' minor secondary role as God of **Anticonsumerism**





## Summary

- Audience interaction drives engagement with talk
- Theme conveyed through tropes, parody, and literary device
- Analogues between objects of contempt and shared universes
- Intentional undermining of presentation highlights the undermining of canons shared universes bring
- Highly critical talk with modern relevance
